## Dear Member / Homeowner

Exciting News...As most of you have heard or seen, construction has restarted on the Fazio Golf Course. Heavy earth moving equipment (scrapers) arrived on site last week and are currently working on holes 2 thru 5 and 10 thru 12. These machines will be operating Monday through Thursday 10 hours a day and will be used to move and remove dirt where needed. When this is completed, additional equipment will be used to shape each hole. Lakes, landscaping and irrigation will be installed upon completion of the shaping and before the final task of seeding, which will bring the course back to life.

Our commitment is to ensure that the golf course will be built in a timely manner without compromising the standards and quality of the end product. Our goals have not changed with regard to the completion and renewal of the greens. I hope that you will see by the very start-up of construction we are focused on accomplishing our objectives in the most expedient manner possible to provide you with a first class golf course that you will enjoy.

## Existing 9<sup>th</sup> hole

Due to the need to add a major sewage and main water line, we will be closing down the #9 green for the remainder of the season. A temporary green will be available shortening the hole but still making it playable. Because of safety issues, after playing the hole we ask you to please observe the directional signage which will lead you around the clubhouse to the pro-shop.

## Summer Hours of Operation

Beginning June 5<sup>th</sup>, the Food/Beverage operations will be closed until October 1<sup>st</sup>. The main clubhouse and golf shop will be closed Mondays and Tuesdays. Anyone wishing to play golf on these days may still do so. The new hours of operation will be from 6:00 AM to 1:00 PM Wednesday thru Sunday.
